







VotesforSchools Lesson Plan: 15 minutes

Will Brexit affect you?

			
1 min	Feedback	Whole class	Students look at the results and feedback from last term's topic.
1-2 mins	1. Why are we talking about this?	Whole class	Students explore why this topic is important at the moment.
3-5 mins	2. What matters to you?	Whole class	Students look at some words and phrases that have been talked about throughout the Brexit process, deciding which they think are the most important to them and why.
6-8 mins	3. What's the big deal?	Individual	Students find out more about the terms on slide 6 and how these are changing due to Brexit. They discuss who will be affected by the changes and whether it will be a benefit or drawback.
3-5 mins	4. The last word	Individual	Students read four different quotes from political leaders and decide who they agree with and why before revealing who said each statement.
N/A	Career Launchpad	Whole class	Students see the topic in action in the real world. See below for details.
N/A	Vote	Whole class	Students review the Yes/No arguments for this topic before casting their vote.
