







VotesforColleges Lesson Plan: 15 minutes

Are we too quick to #cancel?

			
1 min	Feedback	Whole class	Students see the results and feedback from last week's topic.
1-2 mins	1. Why are we talking about this?	Whole class	Students explore why this topic is in the news at the moment.
5-10 mins	2. Who's in the firing line?	Pair	Students look at the six people/organisations and match them to the reason they were "cancelled" recently. Were any of these justified?
5-10 mins	3. Is it model behaviour?	Whole class	Students consider what they look for in a role model before showing their views on different statements by moving to the relevant side of the room. They should be ready to share their views!
5-10 mins	Ext: A Very Important Problem?	Individual	Students read the two examples of how cancel culture has affected less well-known people and decide if either of these changes their view on the topic. Please Note: You can skip this activity if short on time.
1-2 mins	Career Launchpad	Whole class	An opportunity for students to see this topic in action in the real world. See below for details.
N/A	Vote	Whole class	Students review the Yes/No arguments for this topic before casting their vote.
